DAY 1 SUNDAY, JUNE 1

IRON MOUNTAIN, WI

Today we will board our motorcoach and begin our journey north with stops for comfort and lunch on our own along the way. Our day's travels will come to an end in Iron Mountain, MI, where our overnight accommodations and a wonderful welcome dinner await.

MUNISING, MI

DAY 2 MONDAY, JUNE 2

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, we'll visit the World War II Glider and Military Museum, home to one of only seven fully-restored CG-4A gliders in the world. During the war, Ford Motor Company's plant in neighboring Kingsford built more CG-4A gliders for the United States Army than any other company in the nation at a much lower cost. We will then board the motorcoach for the journey to Munising, MI, with stops for lunch and a visit to the Big Spring along the way. Also known as Kitch-iti-Kipi, which means "big cold spring" in the Ojibwe language, Big Spring is Michigan's largest freshwater spring at two hundred feet wide and forty feet deep. Ten thousand gallons of water gush from the underlying limestone every minute at a constant forty-five degree temperature year-round! We'll then enjoy dinner as a group and check into our hotel before embarking on a **boat cruise along Pictured Rocks** National Lakeshore (subject to availability) to admire some of Lake Superior's most stunning shoreline. Our captain will provide narration on the history of the region and turn our attention to points of interest as we sail past brilliantly colored cliffs, sea caves, and pristine beaches.

DAY 3 TUESDAY, JUNE 3

(Breakfast, Boxed Lunch) Following breakfast we'll begin our journey north to the Great Lakes Shipwreck Museum, where we'll delve into compelling tales of sunken vessels and brave crews who faced Superior's formidable storms, resulting in over 200 shipwrecks. Then, marvel at the breathtaking views of Upper Tahguamenon Falls, stretching over 200-feet across and ranking as one of the largest waterfalls east of the Mississippi. The falls' amber-colored waters, scenic surroundings, and soothing sounds create a serene and memorable atmosphere for everyone. Upon arrival in Sault Ste. Marie, MI, you'll enjoy an evening at your leisure in this charming city known for its Franco-Canadian influenced architecture and friendly locals. Take a leisurely stroll along the riverwalk to admire the scenic Soo Locks before indulging in a delicious meal at one of the many restaurants offering regional specialties. We'll cap off the day settling into our overnight accommodations.

DAY 4 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 4

MACKINAC ISLAND, MI

Today's destination is one of the highlights of Michigan – Mackinac Island! We'll catch the ferry this morning and sail to Mackinac Island where motorized vehicles are prohibited and the sounds of waves and horse clops reign. We will be met by horse-drawn carriages and set out on a tour around this three-mile by two-mile island. Relax and listen to stories of the island dating back to the early days of America. Our carriage ride will end at the Grand Hotel, a beautiful National Historic Landmark that beckons guests to a bygone era of old-world charm and exceptional hospitality. Their Grand Luncheon Buffet awaits and is nothing less than fantastic. A favorite island attraction for generations, this daily feast features bountiful tables brimming with crisp garden-fresh salads, wheels of savory cheese, succulent slow-roasted meats, seafood, and more than twenty varieties of tempting fresh-baked pastries. The afternoon is yours to explore this authentic Victorian village. Browse the unique shops of Main Street, wander the peaceful lakefront perimeter, or venture to one of the island's historic landmarks. Another great way to see Mackinac Island is by bicycle, and rentals are plentiful here! We'll settle into this magnificent hotel for a one night stay and experience the grandeur of dinner at the Grand! Afterward, be sure to take in the picturesque sunset over the waters of Lake Huron from the front porch of our hotel. It's the world's longest front porch, and there are plenty of rocking chairs to relax in and enjoy the view!

DAY 5 THURSDAY, JUNE 5

We will say goodbye to Mackinac Island after breakfast and return to the mainland by ferry to meet our motorcoach. Then we're off to Charlevoix, MI, to visit **Castle Farms**. Built as a dairy farm in 1918 by Albert Loeb, the acting president of Sears, Roebuck, and Co., the property boasts soaring towers, stone buildings, and sweeping gardens inspired by European design. Vintage, museum-quality collections of castles, toys, and WWII artifacts are displayed throughout the buildings along with royal family memorabilia from around the world. There's also an outdoor model railroad, the largest in the state of Michigan! We'll learn more about the beautiful estate's one hundred years of history on a private tour that will include a tram ride through the gardens and estate property. A catered luncheon will follow our tour before we check in to our overnight accommodations. We'll end our day with a delicious farewell dinner.

Following breakfast it's time to experience one of Michigan's treasures, the **Saugatuck Dune Rides**.
