DAY 1 MONDAY, JULY 12 OREGON, OH (D)

Set off on an unforgettable journey to one of North America's most spectacular natural wonders—Niagara Falls. Along the way, we'll discover charming communities, rich history, and memorable experiences. Our adventure begins with a scenic drive into the heart of Amish Country in Shipshewana, Indiana, where we'll step back in time during a **relaxing horse-drawn buggy ride** through the peaceful countryside. As we pass picturesque farms and quiet country lanes, learn about the traditions and simple lifestyle of the Amish community. Later this afternoon, continue to **Oregon, Ohio**, where we'll check into our hotel before gathering for a delicious welcome dinner.

DAY 2 TUESDAY, JULY 13 BUFFALO, NY (B, L)

After breakfast, travel east toward **Buffalo, New York**, with a stop for a group lunch along the way. Upon arrival, discover the city's fascinating history and vibrant culture during the **"Best of Buffalo" Tour aboard a double-decker bus**. Along the route, hear captivating stories of the people who once lived and worked at the former Buffalo Psychiatric Center, admire remarkable Gilded Age architecture, and gain insight into the lavish lifestyles of Buffalo's most prominent families. Following the tour, check into our hotel before spending the evening exploring Buffalo's revitalized waterfront. Stroll along scenic walkways overlooking Lake Erie, browse local attractions, or relax at one of the many waterfront restaurants while enjoying the lively atmosphere.

DAY 3 WEDNESDAY, JULY 14 NIAGARA FALLS, ON (B, D)

This morning, continue exploring Buffalo with a visit to the **Buffalo and Erie County Naval & Military Park**, the nation's largest inland naval park. Step aboard three historic vessels, the USS Little Rock, USS The Sullivans, and USS Croaker, for a fascinating look into America's naval history while honoring the men and women who served. Later, travel to **Niagara Falls** for one of the highlights of our journey, the iconic **Maid of the Mist cruise**. Glide past the American Falls and Bridal Veil Falls before venturing into the swirling mist at the base of the mighty Horseshoe Falls. Feel the cool spray, hear the thunderous roar, and experience breathtaking views from a perspective unlike any other. Enjoy some free time to explore Niagara Falls State Park before continuing to another unforgettable attraction, **Cave of the Winds**. Descend 175 feet by elevator into the Niagara Gorge and walk along specially constructed wooden platforms that bring you remarkably close to the rushing waters of Bridal Veil Falls for an exhilarating encounter with the power of nature. Cross into Canada, where our overnight accommodations await. Following dinner, return to the Falls to witness their spectacular **evening illumination** as hundreds of LED lights transform the cascading water into a dazzling display of vibrant color.

DAY 4 THURSDAY, JULY 15 NIAGARA FALLS, ON (B, D)

Begin the day with a visit to the **Niagara Parks Power Station**, where we'll discover the impressive engineering behind one of the region's most significant hydroelectric facilities. During an exclusive behind-the-scenes experience, descend 180 feet in a glass-paneled elevator, then walk through a 2,200-foot tunnel to a scenic observation platform at the river's edge. Next, enjoy free time in the picturesque town of **Niagara-on-the-Lake**. Browse charming boutiques, art galleries, and specialty shops, or relax at one of the inviting cafés while enjoying lunch on your own in this beautifully preserved historic community. This afternoon, experience the beauty of Niagara's celebrated wine country during the **Vine to Wine Tour at Two Sisters Vineyards**. This guided walking tour takes us through the estate's picturesque vineyards and elegant grounds while offering insight into the winemaking process from vine to bottle. Along the way, enjoy a tasting of five estate wines, each showcasing the craftsmanship and distinctive character that have made the vineyard a renowned destination. Before returning to the hotel, stop at the iconic **Floral Clock** near the Niagara Parks Botanical Gardens. Made entirely from thousands of colorful seasonal flowers arranged in intricate patterns that change each year, this beloved landmark provides the perfect backdrop for photos. After time to freshen up, gather once again for a delightful group dinner.



DAY 5 FRIDAY, JULY 16 PERRYSBURG, OH (B, D)

After breakfast, depart for **Frank Lloyd Wright's Graycliff Estate**, beautifully perched along the shores of Lake Erie. Designed in the late 1920s as a summer retreat for the Martin family, Graycliff is considered one of Wright's most exceptional residential masterpieces. During our guided tour, discover his signature architectural style, where open spaces, expansive windows, and seamless connections to the surrounding landscape create a home that feels in perfect harmony with nature. Learn about the Gray family, Wright's innovative design principles, and the estate's lasting architectural and historical significance while admiring its carefully preserved interiors, stunning lake views, and thoughtfully designed gardens. Later, continue to **Perrysburg, Ohio**, where we'll check into our hotel before gathering one final time for a lovely farewell dinner.



DAY 6 SATURDAY, JULY 17 HOME (B)

Following breakfast, we will complete our journey home.
